

## by MADE4ART

MADE4ART is delighted to present Se nascondiamo le parole [If we hide the words], an artistic project with works by Elena Borghi and Stefano Paulon curated by Vittorio Schieroni and Elena Amodeo at their venue at Via Ciovasso 17 in Brera, the art district in the centre of Milan. Paper, the material the two artists use to give substance and shape to the eight pairs of works that are the protagonists of this exhibition, becomes the common terrain for an intense dialogue between different and in some ways complementary sensibilities, a visual setting that, seen as a whole, strikes the observer through the alternation between dark and light colours, through a relationship between evocative coatings and rigorous geometrical elements.

While in the works realized in 2023 by Elena Borghi the scratches on paper with pen nib and black ink are combined with interventions using gloss and matt black paint to give rise to compositions where circles, squares, ovals and rectangles re-emerge, betraying a spasmodic search for harmony by the artist, the collages of the *SQUARES* series by Stefano Paulon, conceived between the 1980s and '90s to then be taken up in various interventions over the years, coming about through the reuse of materials from other projects, reveal a use of geometry as a structural grid, a stylistic feature that demonstrates how the relationship between space and design is fundamental in these works and how this relationship always implies a project-based, constructive movement. The artists in the exhibition at MADE4ART embody different ways of interpreting reality, of representing the laws and the order on which it is based, the impetus and energy of life flowing impetuously in it, including everything. The two languages used by Borghi and Paulon have no need for recourse to words or narratives, but are based exclusively on the tools of investigation and experimentation provided by art.

When they ask me what art is, I always answer that art is a reflection of itself. A delicate balance between the present and the non-present. In my case, the creative process is the result of silent, continuous contemplation that precedes a rigorous mathematical project. My geometrical and three-dimensional works never propose meanings, but aspire solely to offer visual emotions, subtle provocations in minds sensitive to a chromaticism that is minimal yet, in my opinion, spiritual and intense.

Art, the path and the awareness of always having to grow and never rest content.


Elena Borghi

















Elena Borghi was born in Como, the city where she lives and works. After gaining her diploma in painting at the Brera Academy of Fine Arts in Milan, she opened the studio Elena Borghi Disegni, beginning to work as a stylist with Tricot Chic, Colmar and Didier Parakian and as a fabric designer for Italian and foreign companies; in the same period, she continued her artistic training by attending specialist courses in design with the masters Francesco Somaini and Giuliano Collina. Her innate curiosity and determination have prompted the artist to continue drawing, painting and experimenting with various techniques, also creating large-scale works in fabric for installations and set designs, following an artistic path that is eclectic but that has maintained an indisputable recognizability over time. She has displayed her works in numerous solo and group exhibitions in Italy and abroad.

She presented her works at the MADE4ART venue on the occasion of the two-person exhibition with Stefano Paulon "If we hide the words" (2023), documented by the present catalogue and the group exhibition "Black&White in Brera" (2024).

Stefano Paulon, artist, author, designer and collector, was born in 1963 in Cernusco sul Naviglio; he lives and works between Milan, Como and Finale Ligure. During his professional career he has long concerned himself with industrial design and B2B marketing. His attention subsequently shifted towards projects for complementary furnishings and the development of concepts in the lighting engineering and architectural sector. In the artistic field he initially devoted his energies to line drawing, studying the human figure and the development of complex geometrical structures. Conducting in-depth research relating to space, the surface and form and having recourse to a minimalist personal vocabulary, his expressive language has recently arrived at the treatment and modelling of surfaces, to three-dimensional compositions and installations. His exhibition activity today concerns public and private spaces in Italy and abroad. Among his exhibitions at the MADE4ART venue we will mention "Vuoti Solidi" (2021), "Geometrie teofaniche" (2021), "PRIMARIEINTENZIONI" (2022) and the two-person exhibition with Elena Borghi "If we hide the words", documented by the present catalogue and the group exhibition "Black&White in Brera" (2024).
